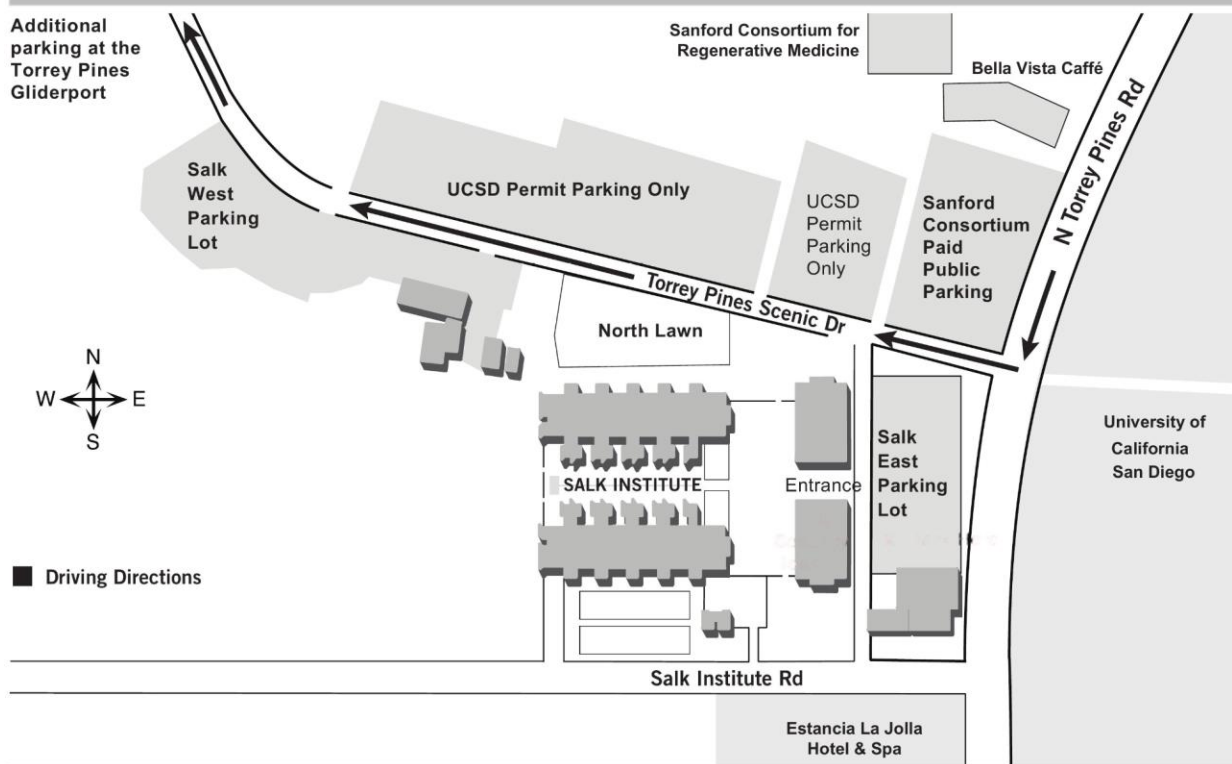


Parking

You may not park at the Salk Institute without a Salk permit. Early arrival is recommended. See parking options and map below.

- **Free parking**
 - Limited street parking on Torrey Pines Scenic Dr.
 - Glider Port unpaved lot at end of and Torrey Pines Scenic Dr.
- **Paid parking**
 - UCSD Managed lots
 - \$4.00/day SUPER SAVER LOT P386 – UCSD gravel lot across the street from Salk Institute on Torrey Pines Scenic Dr (ParkMobile zone 4767)
 - Visitor parking at nearby UCSD paved parking lots/structures is available for an hourly or daily fee \$4.50/hr or daily maximum \$36 (ParkMobile zones vary by site). See interactive [Campus Map](#) for parking locations near Torrey Pines and North Campus
 - Pay at parking pay stations or on mobile device with [ParkMobile App](#).
 - Other nearby lot (Sanford Consortium public parking)
 - \$4.50/hr EAST LOT P357 – (Ace Lot 1680)
 - Scan to Pay: Scan the QR codes posted throughout the parking lots using your smartphone camera.
 - Text to Pay: Text the number displayed on lot signage.
 - Pay by App: Download the [ACE Parking app](#), create an account or log in, and search for the Sanford Consortium parking lot (Lot #1680) to reserve parking.
 - **UCSD Permit Parking**
 - Those with UCSD parking permit will find nearest parking @ PANGEA Parking Structure P406 – located across across the street from Salk Institute, accessible from N Torrey Pines Rd. and Pangea Dr.

Visitor Parking: Limited free parking is available for visitors to the Salk Institute along Torrey Pines Scenic Drive, Salk Institute Road and in the Torrey Pines Gliderport parking lot. Paid public parking is available for an hourly rate at the Sanford Consortium immediately across from the east end of the Salk Institute.
